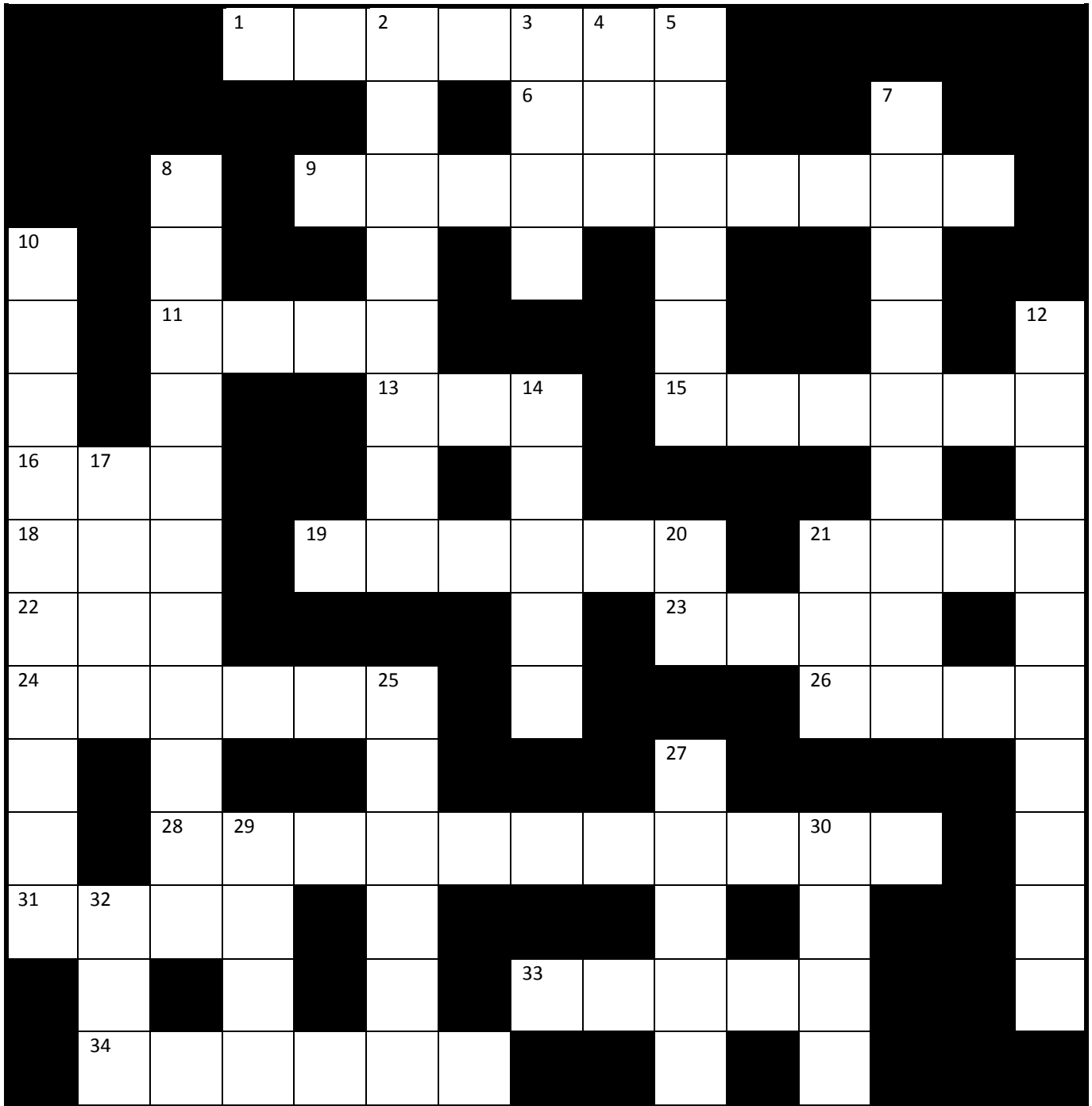




Scientific Method Crossword
